Regulation under the *Building and Services Ordinance* 1924-1976.*

I, ANTHONY ALLAN STALEY, the Minister of State for the Capital Territory, hereby make the following Regulation under the *Building and Services Ordinance* 1924-1976.

AMENDMENT OF THE GARBAGE REGULATIONS

Regulation 5 of the Garbage Regulations is repealed and the following regulation substituted:—

“ 5. (1) The occupier of premises shall not leave or deposit garbage upon or about the premises, or permit garbage to be left upon or about the premises, other than in a receptacle or in a container approved by the Minister or by an authorized officer. Disposal of
garbage.

“ (2) A person who fails to comply with sub-regulation (1) is guilty of an offence and is punishable—

- (a) if an occupier of domestic premises, by a fine not less than \$20 and not more than \$50;
- (b) if an occupier of commercial premises, where the garbage contained putrescible matter directly or indirectly hazardous to human health, by a fine not less than \$200 and not more than \$500; or
- (c) in any other case, by a fine not less than \$100 and not more than \$300.”
