- 1. Regulation 4 of the Health Commission (Charges) Regulations is amended Nursing-bome as set out in the following table:—

- (a) by omitting from sub-regulation (1) the words "The prescribed charge" and substituting the words "Subject to sub-regulation (1A), the prescribed charge"; and
- (b) by inserting, after sub-regulation (1), the following sub-regulation:—
 - "(1A) Where 3 or more persons are transported together in an ambulance, the prescribed charge for the transport of each of those persons is an amount equal to three-quarters of the amount that would, but for this sub-regulation, be the prescribed charge.".
- 3. Regulation 9 of the Health Commission (Charges) Regulations is repealed and the following regulation substituted:-
- "9. The prescribed charge, for the purpose of sub-section 74 (1) of the Supply of Ordinance, for the supply of copies of documents relating to-
 - (a) the accommodation or treatment of a person at a hospital, nursinghome or hostel conducted by the Commission; or
