### PUBLIC HEALTH (FEES) REGULATIONS

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Public Health (Fees) Citation Regulations.

2. These Regulations shall come into operation on 1 January 1980. Commence-

<b>PUBLIC HEALTH (EATING HOUSES) REGULATIONS</b>	
Sub-regulation 4 (1)	Omit “One dollar”, substitute “\$20”.
The Schedule—Form A	Omit “One dollar”, substitute “\$20”.
<b>PUBLIC HEALTH (MEAT) REGULATIONS</b>	
Regulation 4	Omit “One pound” (wherever occurring), substitute “\$20”.
Regulation 6	Omit “without the payment of any fee”, substitute “upon payment of a fee of \$20”.
