**Public Health (Eating Houses) Regulations²
(Amendment)**

I, JAMES JOSEPH CARLTON, the Minister of State for Health, hereby make the following Regulations under the *Public Health Ordinance* 1928.

Interpretation

1. Regulation 2 of the Public Health (Eating Houses) Regulations is amended by inserting after the definition of “approved” the following definition:

“‘Chairman’ means the person for the time being holding, or performing the duties of, the office of Chairman of the Capital Territory Health Commission;”.

Application for, and renewal of, registration

2. Regulation 4 of the Public Health (Eating Houses) Regulations is amended by omitting from sub-regulation (1) “forward therewith a fee of \$20” and substituting “pay a fee of \$20 to the Capital Territory Health Commission.”.
