Regulations 1985 No. 13¹

Public Health (Meat) Regulations² (Amendment)

I, NEAL BLEWETT, the Minister of State for Health, hereby make the following Regulations under the *Public Health Ordinance 1928*.

Interpretation

1. Regulation 2 of the Public Health (Meat) Regulations is amended by omitting the definition of "Animal" and substituting the following definition:

" 'animal' means abattoir animal within the meaning of the Meat Inspection Act 1983;".

Conditions applicable to meat sold

2. Regulation 3 of the Public Health (Meat) Regulations is amended—

- (a) by omitting paragraphs (b) and (c) and substituting the following paragraphs:
 - "(b) the meat is from an animal slaughtered at an abattoir; and
 - (c) the meat is marked, or is from a carcase that is marked, in accordance with the *Meat Inspection Act 1983*."; and
- (b) by adding at the end the following sub-regulation:

"(2) Paragraph (1) (c) does not apply to any carcase, or meat from a carcase, that is—

- (a) marked in accordance with the law of a State or a Territory to which the *Meat Inspection Act 1983* does not extend; and
- (b) imported into the Territory in accordance with that Act.".
