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**Public Health (Meat) Regulations<sup>2</sup>  
(Amendment)**

I, NEAL BLEWETT, the Minister of State for Health, hereby make the following Regulations under the *Public Health Ordinance 1928*.

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**Interpretation**

1. Regulation 2 of the Public Health (Meat) Regulations is amended by omitting the definition of "Animal" and substituting the following definition:

"'animal' means abattoir animal within the meaning of the *Meat Inspection Act 1983*;"

**Conditions applicable to meat sold**

2. Regulation 3 of the Public Health (Meat) Regulations is amended—

(a) by omitting paragraphs (b) and (c) and substituting the following paragraphs:

"(b) the meat is from an animal slaughtered at an abattoir; and

(c) the meat is marked, or is from a carcass that is marked, in accordance with the *Meat Inspection Act 1983*;" and

(b) by adding at the end the following sub-regulation:

"(2) Paragraph (1) (c) does not apply to any carcass, or meat from a carcass, that is—

(a) marked in accordance with the law of a State or a Territory to which the *Meat Inspection Act 1983* does not extend; and

(b) imported into the Territory in accordance with that Act."
