Magistrates Court Rules² (Amendment)

Commencement

1. These Rules commence on the date on which the *Magistrates Court (Amendment) Ordinance 1988* commences.

Court Fees

2. Rule 68 of the Magistrates Court Rules is amended—

(a) by omitting subrule (2) and substituting the following subrule:

“(2) For the purpose of subsection 255C (3) of the Ordinance, the amount shall be calculated at the following rate:

- (a) for each page of the first transcript or copy of the record delivered—\$2.00; and
- (b) for each page of any further transcript or copy provided to the same applicant—\$0.10.”; and

(b) by omitting subrules (3), (4) and (5).
