Regulations 1988 No. 26¹

Public Health (Eating Houses) Regulations² (Amendment)

I, ALLAN CLYDE HOLDING, the Minister of State for the Arts and Territories, hereby make the following Regulations under the *Public Health Ordinance 1928*.

Commencement

1. These Regulations commence on the date of commencement of the *Dog Control (Amendment) Ordinance 1988*.

Prohibition on dogs

2. Regulation 18 of the Public Health (Eating Houses) Regulations is amended—

- (a) by inserting in subregulation (2) “or a hearing dog accompanying a deaf person” after “blind person”; and
- (b) by adding at the end the following subregulation:

“(3) In subregulation (2), ‘blind person’, ‘deaf person’, ‘guide dog’ and ‘hearing dog’ have the same respective meanings as in the *Dog Control Ordinance 1975*.”.
