About this republication

The republished law

This is a republication of the *Guardianship and Management of Property Regulations 1991*, made under the *Guardianship and Management of Property Act 1991* as in force on 21 February 2002. It includes any amendment, repeal or expiry affecting the republished law to 12 September 2001 and any amendment made under the *Legislation Act 2001*, part 11.3 (Editorial changes).

The legislation history and amendment history of the republished law are set out in endnotes 3 and 4.

Kinds of republications

The Parliamentary Counsel's Office prepares 2 kinds of republications of ACT laws (see the ACT legislation register at www.legislation.act.gov.au):

- authorised republications to which the *Legislation Act 2001* applies
- unauthorised republications.

The status of this republication appears on the bottom of each page.

Editorial changes

The *Legislation Act 2001*, part 11.3 authorises the Parliamentary Counsel to make editorial amendments and other changes of a formal nature when preparing a law for republication. Editorial changes do not change the effect of the law, but have effect as if they had been made by an Act commencing on the republication date (see *Legislation Act 2001*, s 115 and s 117). The changes are made if the Parliamentary Counsel considers they are desirable to bring the law into line, or more closely into line, with current legislative drafting practice.

This republication includes amendments made under part 11.3 (see endnote 1).

Uncommenced provisions and amendments

If a provision of the republished law has not commenced or is affected by an uncommenced amendment, the symbol **U** appears immediately before the provision heading. The text of the uncommenced provision or amendment appears only in the last endnote.

Modifications

If a provision of the republished law is affected by a current modification, the symbol **M** appears immediately before the provision heading. The text of the modifying provision appears in the endnotes. For the legal status of modifications, see *Legislation Act 2001*, section 95.

Penalties

The value of a penalty unit for an offence against this republished law at the republication date—

- (a) if the person charged is an individual—\$100; or
- (b) if the person charged is a corporation—\$500.

1 Citation

These regulations may be cited as the *Guardianship and Management of Property Regulations 1991*.

2 Meaning of Act

In these Regulations:

Act means the *Guardianship and Management of Property Act 1991*.

3 Corresponding laws of foreign countries

4 Applications to tribunal

An application to the tribunal shall be in writing and shall be lodged with the president.

6 Manager's accounts

- (1) For the Act, section 26 (1), the following documents are prescribed:
 - (a) a statement of the income of the represented person on the relevant day, including income from the following:
 - (i) pensions;
 - (ii) employment;
 - (iii) superannuation;
 - (iv) investments;
 - (v) rent;
 - (b) a statement of the estimated value of the assets of the represented person on the relevant day, including—
 - (i) amounts standing to the credit of an account with a bank or other financial institution; and
 - (ii) real property; and
 - (iii) personal property; and
 - (iv) investments;

- (c) a statement of the liabilities of the represented person on the relevant day, including details of the creditors, the types of liabilities and the value of the liabilities.
- (2) For the Act, section 26 (1), documents are filed in accordance with these regulations if they are filed within 28 days after the relevant day.
- (3) In this regulation:
 - relevant day*, in relation to a manager, means—
 - (a) the day of the appointment of the manager; and
 - (b) if the manager has acted as manager for a continuous period exceeding 1 year—each anniversary of the appointment of the manager; and
 - (c) if the tribunal directs the manager to file prescribed documents before a specified day—that day.

8 Seal of the tribunal

The seal of the tribunal shall be of a design approved by the president and shall include the name of the tribunal.

1 About the endnotes

Amending and modifying laws are annotated in the legislation history and the amendment history. Current modifications are not included in the republished law but are set out in the endnotes.

Not all editorial amendments made under the *Legislation Act 2001*, part 11.3 are annotated in the amendment history. Full details of any amendments can be obtained from the Parliamentary Counsel's Office.

Uncommenced amending laws are listed in the legislation history and the amendment history. These details are underlined. Uncommenced provisions and amendments are not included in the republished law but are set out in the last endnotes.

If all the provisions of the law have been renumbered, a table of renumbered provisions gives details of previous and current numbering.

The endnotes also include a table of earlier republications.

If the republished law includes penalties, current information about penalty unit values appears on the republication inside front cover.

These regulations were originally the *Guardianship and Management of Property Regulations*. They were renamed under the *Legislation Act 2001* as the *Guardianship and Management Property Regulations 1991*.
