Ombudsman Regulations² (Amendment)

Principal Regulations

1. In these Regulations, “Principal Regulations” means the Ombudsman Regulations.

Insertion

2. After regulation 1 of the Principal Regulations the following regulation is inserted:

Interpretation

“1A. In these Regulations, unless the contrary intention appears—
‘the Act’ means the *Ombudsman Act 1989*.”.

Certain persons not to be prescribed authorities

3. Regulation 2 of the Principal Regulations is amended by omitting “*Ombudsman Act 1989*” and substituting “Act”.

Insertion

4. After regulation 2 of the Principal Regulations the following regulation is inserted:

Prescribed authorities

“2A. Pursuant to paragraph (b) of the definition of ‘prescribed authority’ in subsection 3 (1) of the Act, a body specified in Schedule 1A is declared to be a prescribed authority for the purposes of the Act.”.

Principal officer

5. Regulation 3 of the Principal Regulations is amended by omitting “*Ombudsman Act 1989*” and substituting “Act”.

Insertion

6. After Schedule 1 of the Principal Regulations the following Schedule is inserted:
