Public Health (Infectious and Notifiable Diseases) Regulations (Amendment)

Principal Regulations

1. In these Regulations, “Principal Regulations” means the Public Health (Infectious and Notifiable Diseases) Regulations.²

Interpretation

2. Regulation 3 is amended by omitting from subregulation (1) the definitions of “Infectious Disease” and “Notifiable Disease” and substituting the following definitions:

- “ ‘infectious disease’ means a disease specified in Schedule 3;
- ‘notifiable disease’ means a disease specified in Schedule 4;”.

Addition

3. The Principal Regulations are amended by adding at the end the following Schedules:
