## Electoral Regulations

Subordinate Law No. 24 of 1993<sup>1</sup>

### Citation

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Electoral Regulations.

### Commencement

2. These Regulations commence on the day on which they are notified in the *Gazette*.

### Interpretation

3. In these Regulations, unless the contrary intention appears—  
“Act” means the *Electoral Act 1992*.

**Remuneration**

**4. (1)** The Chairperson is entitled to be paid remuneration at the rate of \$20,000 per year.

**(2)** The Electoral Commissioner is entitled to be paid remuneration at the rate of \$25,000 per year.

**(3)** The other member is entitled to be paid remuneration at the rate of \$12,500 per year.

**Allowances**

**5. (1)** Where, to attend a meeting or otherwise in the performance of functions under the Act, it is necessary for a member to travel to or from the Territory, he or she is entitled to be paid—

- (a) a travelling allowance in respect of that travel; and
- (b) if he or she travels in a motor vehicle owned or hired by him or her—motor vehicle allowance in respect of that travel.

**(2)** Travelling allowance payable under paragraph (1) (a)—

- (a) is the same as the travelling allowance payable to an officer of the Senior Executive Service in the Australian Public Service; and
- (b) is in addition to, and does not include, the cost of conveyance.

**(3)** Motor vehicle allowance payable under paragraph (1) (b) is the same as the motor vehicle allowance payable to an officer of the Australian Public Service.

**(4)** In this regulation, “member” includes the Electoral Commissioner.
