Food Regulations

Subordinate Law No. 4 of 1994¹

Citation

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Food Regulations.

Commencement

2. (1) Regulations 1, 2 and 3 commence on the day on which these Regulations are notified in the *Gazette*.

(2) Regulation 4 commences on the day on which section 19D of the Act commences.

Interpretation

3. In these Regulations, unless the contrary intention appears—
“the Act” means the *Food Act 1992*.

Exemptions from licensing requirements

4. For the purposes of subsection 19D (2) of the Act—
- (a) a person who carries on a food business consisting solely of—
 - (i) selling, by retail, non-perishable and pre-packaged food;
 - (ii) the transportation of food; or
 - (iii) the sale and delivery of milk to residential premises in accordance with a vendor’s permit or a vendor’s licence granted under the *Milk Authority Act 1971*; or
 - (b) a person who carries on business in a State (being a business in respect of which the person holds a licence or is otherwise authorised under the law of that State corresponding to the Act) and who carries on a food business consisting solely of, on not more than 2 occasions in any calendar year, selling food from a vehicle at a show, festival or other outdoor activity in the Territory of not more than 3 days duration;

is exempt from subsection 19D (1) of the Act.
