Subordinate Law No. 40 of 1994²

Principal Regulations

1. In these Regulations, “Principal Regulations” means the Liquor Regulations.

Commencement

2. These Regulations commence on the day on which they are notified in the *Gazette*.

Prescribed public places

3. Regulation 11 of the Principal Regulations is amended—

- (a) by omitting from subregulation (2) “Sunday 26 December 1993” and “Friday 31 December 1993” and substituting “Monday 26 December 1994” and “Saturday 31 December 1994”, respectively; and
- (b) by omitting paragraph (3) (b) and substituting the following paragraphs:
 - “(ab) Antill Street between its intersection with the Federal Highway and the entrance to the Australian Heritage Village;
 - (b) Northbourne Avenue north of the southernmost point of its intersection with Macarthur Avenue and Wakefield Avenue;”.
