## **Supreme Court (Remuneration and Allowances) Regulations<sup>1</sup> (Amendment)**

### **Commencement**

1. These Regulations commence on 8 July 1996.

**Remuneration and allowances**

2. Regulation 3 of the Supreme Court (Remuneration and Allowances) Regulations is amended—

- (a) by omitting from subregulation (1) all the words after “rate of” and substituting “\$1,000 per day”;
- (b) by omitting from subregulation (2) all the words after “allowance of” and substituting “\$100 per day”; and
- (c) by adding at the end the following subregulation:

“(3) In this regulation—

‘day’, in relation to the remuneration or allowance of an acting Judge, means any day of the week (except a Saturday, Sunday or public holiday) on which the acting Judge exercises the powers, or performs the duties, of a Judge.”.
