

# **Building Regulations**<sup>1</sup> (Amendment)

Subordinate Law No. 3 of 1996<sup>2</sup>

#### Commencement

**1.** These Regulations commence on the day on which they are notified in the *Gazette*.

#### **Principal Regulations**

**2.** In these Regulations, "Principal Regulations" means the Building Regulations.

#### **Insertion**

**3.** After regulation 3 of the Principal Regulations the following regulations are inserted:

#### Cost of work

"4. For the purposes of paragraph 58B (c) of the Act, the prescribed amount is \$5,000.

#### **Expiration of warranty**

"5. For the purposes of subsection 58C (3) of the Act, the prescribed period is 5 years.

### Residential building work insurance

- "6. (1) For the purposes of paragraph 58E (1) (b) of the Act, the prescribed amount is \$85,000.
- "(2) For the purposes of paragraphs 58E (1) (c) and (d) of the Act, the prescribed period is 5 years.
- "(3) For the purposes of paragraph 58E (1) (j) of the Act, the prescribed period is 90 days.
- "(4) For the purposes of subsection 58E (2) of the Act, the prescribed amount is \$500.
- "(5) For the purposes of paragraph 58E (7) (f) of the Act, the prescribed amount is \$10,000.".
