Bushfire Regulations¹ (Amendment)

Subordinate Law No. 8 of 1998²

The Australian Capital Territory Executive makes the following Regulations under the *Bushfire Act 1936*.

Commencement

1. These Regulations commence on the day on which they are notified in the *Gazette*.

Prescribed fires

2. Regulation 6 of the *Bushfire Regulations* is amended by adding at the end the following paragraph:

- “(d) a fire lit, maintained or used to enable a hot-air balloon to become or stay airborne or to control the descent of such a balloon if—
- (i) the balloon is under the control of a responsible person who is present at all times when the fire is in use;
 - (ii) an area of not less than 3 metres around the balloon is cleared of flammable material before the fire is lit; and
 - (iii) a means of applying a continuous stream of water is available for immediate use at the place at which the fire is lit.”.
