Motor Vehicle (Third Party Insurance) Regulations¹ (Amendment)

Subordinate Law No. 2 of 1999²

1. Commencement

These Regulations commence on 8 March 1999.

2. Principal Regulations

In these Regulations, “Principal Regulations” means the *Motor Vehicle (Third Party Insurance) Regulations*.

3. Schedule 1

Schedule 1 to the Principal Regulations is amended by omitting paragraph (a) of item 3 of Part II and substituting the following paragraphs:

“(a)where the unladen weight does not exceed 975 kilograms 332.50
(ab)where the unladen weight exceeds 975 kilograms but does not exceed 2 tonnes..... 481.50”.

4. Schedule 2

Schedule 2 to the Principal Regulations is amended by omitting paragraph (a) of item 3 of the list in Form O and substituting the following paragraphs:

“(a)where the unladen weight does not exceed 975 kilograms
(ab)where the unladen weight exceeds 975 kilograms but does not exceed 2 tonnes”.
