### **1 Commencement**

These regulations commence on 1 July 1999.

**2 Principal Regulations**

In these regulations, “Principal Regulations” means the *Motor Vehicle (Third Party Insurance) Regulations*.

**3 Citation**

Regulation 1 of the Principal Regulations is amended by adding at the end “1947”.

**4 Premium rates**

Regulation 16 of the Principal Regulations is amended by omitting from subregulation (2) “\$133.50” and substituting “\$107.50”.

**5 Schedule 1**

Schedule 1 to the Principal Regulations is amended by omitting Part 2 and substituting the following Part:
