The republished law

This is a republication of the *Road Transport (Alcohol and Drugs) Regulations 2000* effective from 24 May 2001 to 11 September 2001.

Editorial changes do not change the effect of the law, but have effect as if they had been made by an Act commencing on the republication date (see *Legislation (Republication) Act 1996*, s 14 and s 16). The changes are made if the Parliamentary Counsel considers they are desirable to bring the law into line, or more closely into line, with current legislative drafting practice.

1 Name of regulations

These regulations are the *Road Transport (Alcohol and Drugs) Regulations 2000*.

3 Definition

In these regulations, the following definition applies:

the Act means the *Road Transport (Alcohol and Drugs) Act 1977*.

4 Statements for the Act, s (5)

A written statement mentioned in the Act, subsection 12 (5) must contain the particulars set out in schedule 1.

Schedule 1 Particulars for breath analysis carried out using a Dräger Alcotest 7110 or a Dräger Alcotest 7110 Mkv

(see reg 4)

- 1 The type and serial number of the instrument used in carrying out the breath analysis and the sample number of the test.
- 2 The date, start time and location where the test was carried out.
- 3 The full name and date of birth of the person providing a sample of his or her breath for analysis.
- 4 The full name of the police officer who has custody of the person under the Act, section 11 (who may be referred to in the statement as the *informant*).
- 5 The full name and rank of the approved operator.
- 6 Whether self-tests were conducted on the instrument before and after analysis and the time and the result of any such test.
- 7 If the breath sample was tested on ‘override’ mode, that fact.
- 8 The date and time when the sample of breath was analysed.
- 9 The result of the breath analysis as shown by the instrument.

Uncommenced amending laws are listed in the legislation history and the amendment history. These details are underlined. Uncommenced provisions and amendments are not included in the republished law but are set out in the last endnotes.

If all the provisions of the law have been renumbered, a table of renumbered provisions gives details of previous and current numbering.

The endnotes also include a table of earlier republications.

If the republished law includes penalties, current information about penalty unit values appears on the republication inside front cover.
