1 Commencement

These regulations commence on 1 March 2001.

2 Regulations amended

These regulations amend the *Road Transport (Third-Party Insurance) Regulations 2000.*

3 New regulation 11A

insert

11A Maximum premiums for late renewal

- (1) This regulation applies to a third-party policy for a vehicle if the registration of the vehicle has expired and the third-party policy is needed for a renewal of the registration.
- (2) Despite regulation 11, the maximum premium that may be charged for the third-party policy is the maximum premium that could have been charged under regulation 11 for the policy if the policy had been renewed before the registration of the vehicle expired.
- (3) This regulation does not apply to the renewal of a seasonal vehicle.
