1 Name of regulations

These regulations are the *Road Transport (Safety and Traffic Management) Amendment Regulations 2003 (No 1)*.

2 Commencement

These regulations commence on a day fixed by the Minister by written notice.

Note 1 The naming and commencement provisions automatically commence on the notification day (see Legislation Act, s 75 (1)).

Note 2 A single day or time may be fixed, or different days or times may be fixed, for the commencement of different provisions (see Legislation Act, s 77 (1)).

Note 3 If a provision has not commenced within 6 months beginning on the notification day, it automatically commences on the first day after that period (see Legislation Act, s 79).

3 Regulations amended

These regulations amend the *Road Transport (Safety and Traffic Management) Regulations 2000*.

8A ARR r 25 (2)—default speed-limit in built-up area

For the Australian Road Rules, rule 25 (1), and despite rule 25 (2), the *default speed-limit* applying to a driver for a length of road in a built-up area is 50km/h.

Note ARR r 25 (2) provides a 60km/h default speed-limit for a built-up area.
