1 Name of regulations

These regulations are the *Road Transport (Offences) Amendment Regulations 2003 (No 2)*.

2 Commencement

These regulations commence on the day after their notification day.

Note The naming and commencement provisions automatically commence on the notification day (see Legislation Act, s 75 (1)).

3 Legislation amended

These regulations amend the *Road Transport (Offences) Regulations 2001*.

4 Regulation 6

substitute

6 Infringement notice penalties—Act, dict, def of *infringement notice penalty, par (a)*

- (1) The penalty payable by a person under an infringement notice for an infringement notice offence is the amount mentioned in schedule 1, column 5 of the item applying to the offence or, if there is more than 1 amount mentioned in the column, the amount applying to the person.
- (2) However, if the infringement notice offence is a camera-detected offence and the person is a corporation, the penalty payable by the person for the infringement notice offence is 5 times the amount applying to the person under subregulation (1) for the offence.
- (3) In this regulation:
camera-detected offence—see the Act, dictionary.
