About this republication

The republished law

This is a republication of the *Magistrates Court (Fisheries Infringement Notices) Regulation* 2004, made under the *Magistrates Court Act 1930* (including any amendment made under the *Legislation Act 2001*, part 11.3 (Editorial changes)) as in force on 1 November 2004. It also includes any amendment, repeal or expiry affecting the republished law to 1 November 2004.

The legislation history and amendment history of the republished law are set out in endnotes 3 and 4.

Kinds of republications

The Parliamentary Counsel's Office prepares 2 kinds of republications of ACT laws (see the ACT legislation register at www.legislation.act.gov.au):

- authorised republications to which the Legislation Act 2001 applies
- unauthorised republications.

The status of this republication appears on the bottom of each page.

Editorial changes

The *Legislation Act 2001*, part 11.3 authorises the Parliamentary Counsel to make editorial amendments and other changes of a formal nature when preparing a law for republication. Editorial changes do not change the effect of the law, but have effect as if they had been made by an Act commencing on the republication date (see *Legislation Act 2001*, s 115 and s 117). The changes are made if the Parliamentary Counsel considers they are desirable to bring the law into line, or more closely into line, with current legislative drafting practice.

This republication includes amendments made under part 11.3 (see endnote 1).

Uncommenced provisions and amendments

If a provision of the republished law has not commenced or is affected by an uncommenced amendment, the symbol \boxed{U} appears immediately before the provision heading. The text of the uncommenced provision or amendment appears only in the last endnote.

Modifications

If a provision of the republished law is affected by a current modification, the symbol $\boxed{\mathbf{M}}$ appears immediately before the provision heading. The text of the modifying provision appears in the endnotes. For the legal status of modifications, see *Legislation Act 2001*, section 95.

Penalties

The value of a penalty unit for an offence against this republished law at the republication date is—

- (a) if the person charged is an individual—\$100; or
- (b) if the person charged is a corporation—\$500.

Name of regulation

This regulation is the *Magistrates Court (Fisheries Infringement Notices) Regulation 2004.*

U 3

Purpose of regulation

The purpose of this regulation is to provide for infringement notices under the *Magistrates Court Act 1930*, part 8 for certain offences against the fisheries legislation.

Note The *Magistrates Court Act 1930*, pt 8 provides a system of infringement notices for offences against various Acts. The infringement notice system is intended to provide an alternative to prosecution.

4 Notes

A note included in this regulation is explanatory and is not part of this regulation.

Note See the Legislation Act, s 127 (1), (4) and (5) for the legal status of notes.

5 Meaning of fisheries legislation

In this regulation:

fisheries legislation means-

- (a) the Fisheries Act 2000; and
- (b) the Fisheries Regulation 2001.

6 Administering authority

The administering authority for an infringement notice offence against the fisheries legislation is the conservator of flora and fauna.

Infringement notice offences

The Magistrates Court Act 1930, part 8 applies to an offence against a provision of the fisheries legislation mentioned in schedule 1, column 2.

8 Infringement notice penalties

- (1) The penalty payable by an individual for an offence against the fisheries legislation, under an infringement notice for the offence, is the amount mentioned in schedule 1, column 4 for the offence.
- (2) The penalty payable by a corporation for an offence against the fisheries legislation, under an infringement notice for the offence, is 5 times the amount mentioned in schedule 1, column 4 for the offence.
- (3) The cost of serving a reminder notice for an infringement notice offence against the fisheries legislation is \$34.

Contents of infringement notices—other information

- (1) An infringement notice served on a company by an authorised person for an infringement notice offence against the fisheries legislation must include the company's ACN.
 - The requirement under this section is additional to the requirement Note under the Magistrates Court Act 1930, s 121 (1) (c).
- (2) In this section:

company means a company registered under the Corporations Act.

10 Contents of infringement notices—identifying authorised person

An infringement notice served on a person by an authorised person for an infringement notice offence against the fisheries legislation must identify the authorised person by-

- (a) the authorised person's full name, or surname and initials; or
- (b) any unique number given to the authorised person by the administering authority for this regulation.

11 Contents of reminder notices—identifying authorised person

A reminder notice served on a person by an authorised person for an infringement notice offence against the fisheries legislation must identify the authorised person by—

- (a) the authorised person's full name, or surname and initials; or
- (b) any unique number given to the authorised person by the administering authority for this regulation.

12 Authorised people for infringement notice offences

A conservation officer under the *Nature Conservation Act 1980*, section 8 may serve—

- (a) an infringement notice for an infringement notice offence against the fisheries legislation; and
- (b) a reminder notice for an infringement notice offence against the fisheries legislation.
