1 Name of regulation

This regulation is the *Tree Protection Regulation 2006*.

2 Commencement

This regulation commences on the day after its notification day.

Note The naming and commencement provisions automatically commence on the notification day (see Legislation Act, s 75 (1)).

3 Transitional provision—Act, s 121 (1)

- (1) This section applies if, before the commencement of the new Act—
 - (a) an application was made to the AAT for review of a decision of the conservator under the old Act; and
 - (b) the application had not been finally decided.
- (2) To remove any doubt, the criteria determined under the old Act, section 12 (Criteria for approval) continue to apply for the purposes of deciding the application.
- (3) To remove any doubt, this section is additional to, and does not limit, the Legislation Act, section 84 (Saving of operation of repealed and amended laws).
- (4) In this section:

new Act means the *Tree Protection Act 2005*.

old Act means the *Tree Protection (Interim Scheme) Act 2001* (repealed).

4 Expiry of regulation

This regulation expires 1 year after the day it commences.
