Part 1 Preliminary

1 Name of regulation

This regulation is the *Road Transport Legislation Amendment Regulation 2008 (No 1)*.

2 Commencement

This regulation commences on the day after its notification day.

Note The naming and commencement provisions automatically commence on the notification day (see Legislation Act, s 75 (1)).

Part 2 Road Transport (Driver Licensing) Regulation 2000

3 Legislation amended—pt 2

This part amends the *Road Transport (Driver Licensing) Regulation 2000*.

4 New section 84 (3)

insert

- (3) The road transport authority may include information or material not related to driver licences with notices of renewal sent to licence holders if satisfied on reasonable grounds that providing the information or material is in the public interest.

Example—information or material that may be provided in the public interest
promotional information or material that is part of a public awareness campaign on a health or safety issue

Note An example is part of the regulation, is not exhaustive and may extend, but does not limit, the meaning of the provision in which it appears (see Legislation Act, s 126 and s 132).

Part 3 Road Transport (Vehicle Registration) Regulation 2000

5 Legislation amended—pt 3

This part amends the *Road Transport (Vehicle Registration) Regulation 2000*.

6 New section 67 (4)

insert

- (4) The road transport authority may include information or material not related to vehicle registration with notices of renewal sent to registered operators if satisfied on reasonable grounds that providing the information or material is in the public interest.

Example—information or material that may be provided in the public interest
promotional information or material that is part of a public awareness campaign on a health or safety issue

Note An example is part of the regulation, is not exhaustive and may extend, but does not limit, the meaning of the provision in which it appears (see Legislation Act, s 126 and s 132).
