About this republication

The republished law

This is a republication of the *Housing Assistance Regulation 2008* (repealed), made under the *Housing Assistance Act 2007*, including any amendment made under the *Legislation Act 2001*, part 11.3 (Editorial changes). It also includes any commencement, amendment, repeal or expiry affecting the republished law to 11 November 2008.

The legislation history and amendment history of the republished law are set out in endnotes 3 and 4.

Kinds of republications

The Parliamentary Counsel's Office prepares 2 kinds of republications of ACT laws (see the ACT legislation register at www.legislation.act.gov.au):

- authorised republications to which the *Legislation Act 2001* applies
- unauthorised republications.

The status of this republication appears on the bottom of each page.

Editorial changes

The Legislation Act 2001, part 11.3 authorises the Parliamentary Counsel to make editorial amendments and other changes of a formal nature when preparing a law for republication. Editorial changes do not change the effect of the law, but have effect as if they had been made by an Act commencing on the republication date (see Legislation Act 2001, s 115 and s 117). The changes are made if the Parliamentary Counsel considers they are desirable to bring the law into line, or more closely into line, with current legislative drafting practice.

This republication does not include amendments made under part 11.3 (see endnote 1).

Uncommenced provisions and amendments

If a provision of the republished law has not commenced or is affected by an uncommenced amendment, the symbol $\boxed{\textbf{U}}$ appears immediately before the provision heading. The text of the uncommenced provision or amendment appears only in the last endnote.

Modifications

If a provision of the republished law is affected by a current modification, the symbol **M** appears immediately before the provision heading. The text of the modifying provision appears in the endnotes. For the legal status of modifications, see *Legislation Act* 2001, section 95.

Penalties

The value of a penalty unit for an offence against this republished law at the republication date is—

- (a) if the person charged is an individual—\$100; or
- (b) if the person charged is a corporation—\$500.

1 Name of regulation

This regulation is the *Housing Assistance Regulation 2008*.

3 Modification of Act, s 101—Act, s 109

The Act, section 101 is modified by inserting the following:

- (3A) If immediately before 10 November 2007, a right or asset vested in the commissioner under the old Act, the right or asset vests in the housing commissioner.
- (3B) If immediately before 10 November 2007, the commissioner under the old Act was under a liability or obligation, the liability or obligation attaches to the housing commissioner.
- Subsections (3A) and (3B) and this subsection expire on 10 November 2008.

4 Modification of Act, pt 10, new section 102A—Act, s 109

The Act, part 10 is modified by inserting the following:

102A Transitional—mentions of commissioner

- (1) In an Act, an instrument made under an Act or document, a reference to the commissioner under the old Act is taken to be a reference to the housing commissioner.
- (2) This section expires on 10 November 2008.

5 Modification of Act, pt 10, new section 103A—Act, s 109

The Act, part 10 is modified by inserting the following:

103A Transitional—other uncompleted proceedings

- (1) This section applies if—
 - (a) before the commencement of this section (the *commencement*), an application to a court had been made; and
 - (b) the commissioner under the old Act was a party to a court proceeding; and
 - (c) immediately before the commencement, the proceeding on the application had not ended.
- (2) The housing commissioner is taken to be substituted for the commissioner for the purpose of the proceeding.
- (3) In this section:

court means the Supreme Court or the Magistrates Court.

- (4) This section is a law to which the Legislation Act, section 88 (Repeal does not end effect of transitional laws etc) applies.
- (5) This section expires on 10 November 2008.

6 Expiry

This regulation expires on 10 November 2008.

1 About the endnotes

Amending and modifying laws are annotated in the legislation history and the amendment history. Current modifications are not included in the republished law but are set out in the endnotes.

Not all editorial amendments made under the Legislation Act 2001, part 11.3 are annotated in the amendment history. Full details of any amendments can be obtained from the Parliamentary Counsel's Office.

Uncommenced amending laws and expiries are listed in the legislation history and the amendment history. These details are underlined. Uncommenced provisions and amendments are not included in the republished law but are set out in the last endnote.

If all the provisions of the law have been renumbered, a table of renumbered provisions gives details of previous and current numbering.

The endnotes also include a table of earlier republications.
