1 Name of rules

These rules are the *Court Procedures Amendment Rules* 2009 (No 1).

2 Commencement

These rules commence on the commencement of the *Domestic Violence and Protection Orders Act 2008*.

Note The naming and commencement provisions automatically commence on the notification day (see Legislation Act, s 75 (1)).
