## **1 Name of rules**

These rules are the *Court Procedures Amendment Rules 2009 (No 1)*.

## **2 Commencement**

These rules commence on the commencement of the *Domestic Violence and Protection Orders Act 2008*.

*Note* The naming and commencement provisions automatically commence on the notification day (see Legislation Act, s 75 (1)).
