1 Name of regulation

This regulation is the *Plastic Shopping Bags Ban Regulation 2011*.

2 Commencement

This regulation commences on 1 July 2011.

Biodegradable bag—Act, dict, def biodegradable bag

The prescribed requirements are that a plastic bag is made from plastic that is compostable in accordance with AS 4736-2006.
