1 Name of regulation

This regulation is the *Civil Law (Wrongs) Amendment Regulation 2012 (No 1)*.

2 Commencement

This regulation commences on the day after its notification day.

12A Disclosure of confidential information in general reports—Act, s 204 (4) (f)

Disclosure for the purpose of complying with a request for confidential information made by a public servant who certifies the following is prescribed:

- (a) the public servant is responsible for administering a provision of the *Workers Compensation Act 1951* on behalf of the Territory;
- (b) the information will only be used for administering the provision.
