1 Name of regulation

This regulation is the *Road Transport (Vehicle Registration) Amendment Regulation 2012 (No 1)*.

2 Commencement

This regulation commences on the day after its notification day.

Note The naming and commencement provisions automatically commence on the notification day (see Legislation Act, s 75 (1)).

3 Legislation amended

This regulation amends the *Road Transport (Vehicle Registration) Regulation 2000*.

4 New section 32A (3) (ab) and notes

(ab) the vehicle was a registered vehicle when it became a written-off vehicle; and

Note 1 A vehicle is a registered vehicle if it is registered in the ACT under the *Road Transport (Vehicle Registration) Act 1999*.

Note 2 A reference to an Act includes a reference to the statutory instruments made or in force under the Act, including any regulation (see Legislation Act, s 104).
