1 Name of regulation

This regulation is the *Gaming Machine Amendment Regulation 2014 (No 2)*.

2 Commencement

This regulation commences on the day after its notification day.

Note The naming and commencement provisions automatically commence on the notification day (see [Legislation Act](#), s 75 (1)).

3 Legislation amended

This regulation amends the *Gaming Machine Regulation 2004*.

4 Section 75

substitute

**75 Offence to operate high-denomination note acceptor—
Act, s 178 (2) (a)**

- (1) A licensee commits an offence if the licensee operates a note acceptor that accepts bank notes in denominations of \$100.

Maximum penalty: 5 penalty units.

- (2) An offence against subsection (1) is a strict liability offence.
