1 Name of regulation

This regulation is the *Gaming Machine Amendment Regulation* 2015 (No 1).

2 Commencement

This regulation commences on the day after its notification day.

Note The naming and commencement provisions automatically commence on the notification day (see Legislation Act, s 75 (1)).

3 Legislation amended

This regulation amends the Gaming Machine Regulation 2004.

4 Section 75

substitute

75 Offence to operate high-denomination note acceptor—Act, s 178 (2) (a)

- (1) A licensee commits an offence if the licensee operates a note acceptor that accepts bank notes in denominations of \$50 or \$100.
 - Maximum penalty: 5 penalty units.
- (2) An offence against this section is a strict liability offence.
