About this republication

The republished law

This is a republication of the *Nature Conservation (Transitional Provisions) Regulation 2015* (repealed), made under the *Nature Conservation Act 2014*, including any amendment made under the *Legislation Act 2001*, part 11.3 (Editorial changes). It also includes any commencement, amendment, repeal or expiry affecting this republished law to 12 June 2017.

The legislation history and amendment history of the republished law are set out in endnotes 3 and 4.

Kinds of republications

The Parliamentary Counsel's Office prepares 2 kinds of republications of ACT laws (see the ACT legislation register at www.legislation.act.gov.au):

- authorised republications to which the *Legislation Act 2001* applies
- unauthorised republications.

The status of this republication appears on the bottom of each page.

Editorial changes

The *Legislation Act 2001*, part 11.3 authorises the Parliamentary Counsel to make editorial amendments and other changes of a formal nature when preparing a law for republication. Editorial changes do not change the effect of the law, but have effect as if they had been made by an Act commencing on the republication date (see *Legislation Act 2001*, s 115 and s 117). The changes are made if the Parliamentary Counsel considers they are desirable to bring the law into line, or more closely into line, with current legislative drafting practice.

This republication does not include amendments made under part 11.3 (see endnote 1).

Uncommenced provisions and amendments

If a provision of the republished law has not commenced, the symbol **U** appears immediately before the provision heading. Any uncommenced amendments that affect this republished law are accessible on the ACT legislation register (www.legislation.act.gov.au). For more information, see the home page for this law on the register.

Modifications

If a provision of the republished law is affected by a current modification, the symbol **M** appears immediately before the provision heading. The text of the modifying provision appears in the endnotes. For the legal status of modifications, see the *Legislation Act 2001*, section 95.

Penalties

At the republication date, the value of a penalty unit for an offence against this law is \$150 for an individual and \$750 for a corporation (see *Legislation Act 2001*, s 133).

1 Name of regulation

This regulation is the *Nature Conservation (Transitional Provisions) Regulation 2015 (repealed)*.

5 Modification of Act, ch 20—Act, s 414 (2)

The Act, chapter 20 applies as if the following section were inserted:

‘404A Notification of lists

- (1) A list made by the Minister under section 63 is, if notified, taken to be a list of species notified under section 91 (2) (a).
- (2) A list made by the Minister under section 69 is, if notified, taken to be a list of ecological communities notified under section 91 (2) (b).

Note A notifiable instrument must be notified under the [Legislation Act](#).

- (3) This section expires on the day the *Nature Conservation (Transitional Provisions) Regulation 2015* expires.’

6 Expiry—regulation

This regulation expires on the day the *Nature Conservation Act 2014*, chapter 20 expires.

Note 2 For example, the [Legislation Act](#), dict, pt 1, defines the following terms:

Note 3 Terms used in this regulation have the same meaning that they have in the [Nature Conservation Act 2014](#) (see [Legislation Act](#), s 148). For example, the following terms are defined in the [Nature Conservation Act 2014](#), dict:

- ecological community (see s 17)
- species (see s 15).

1 About the endnotes

Amending and modifying laws are annotated in the legislation history and the amendment history. Current modifications are not included in the republished law but are set out in the endnotes.

Not all editorial amendments made under the *Legislation Act 2001*, part 11.3 are annotated in the amendment history. Full details of any amendments can be obtained from the Parliamentary Counsel's Office.

Uncommenced amending laws are not included in the republished law. The details of these laws are underlined in the legislation history. Uncommenced expiries are underlined in the legislation history and amendment history.

If all the provisions of the law have been renumbered, a table of renumbered provisions gives details of previous and current numbering.

The endnotes also include a table of earlier republications.
