1 Name of regulation

This regulation is the *Road Transport (Third-Party Insurance) Amendment Regulation 2017 (No 1)*.

2 Commencement

This regulation commences on the day after its notification day.

Note The naming and commencement provisions automatically commence on the notification day (see [Legislation Act](#), s 75 (1)).

3 Legislation amended

This regulation amends the *Road Transport (Third-Party Insurance) Regulation 2008*.

4 Schedule 1, section 1.1, definition of *breakdown vehicle*

substitute

breakdown vehicle means a tow truck within the meaning of the *Road Transport (Vehicle Registration) Regulation 2000*.
