About this republication

The republished law

This is a republication of the *Mutual Recognition (Australian Capital Territory) Regulation 2017* (repealed), made under the *Mutual Recognition (Australian Capital Territory) Act 1992*, including any amendment made under the *Legislation Act 2001*, part 11.3 (Editorial changes). It also includes any commencement, amendment, repeal or expiry affecting this republished law to 9 December 2018.

The legislation history and amendment history of the republished law are set out in endnotes 3 and 4.

Kinds of republications

The Parliamentary Counsel's Office prepares 2 kinds of republications of ACT laws (see the ACT legislation register at www.legislation.act.gov.au):

- authorised republications to which the *Legislation Act 2001* applies
- unauthorised republications.

The status of this republication appears on the bottom of each page.

Editorial changes

The *Legislation Act 2001*, part 11.3 authorises the Parliamentary Counsel to make editorial amendments and other changes of a formal nature when preparing a law for republication. Editorial changes do not change the effect of the law, but have effect as if they had been made by an Act commencing on the republication date (see *Legislation Act 2001*, s 115 and s 117). The changes are made if the Parliamentary Counsel considers they are desirable to bring the law into line, or more closely into line, with current legislative drafting practice.

This republication does not include amendments made under part 11.3 (see endnote 1).

Uncommenced provisions and amendments

If a provision of the republished law has not commenced, the symbol **U** appears immediately before the provision heading. Any uncommenced amendments that affect this republished law are accessible on the ACT legislation register (www.legislation.act.gov.au). Modifications

If a provision of the republished law is affected by a current modification, the symbol **M** appears immediately before the provision heading. The text of the modifying provision appears in the endnotes. For the legal status of modifications, see the *Legislation Act 2001*, section 95.

Penalties

At the republication date, the value of a penalty unit for an offence against this law is \$160 for an individual and \$810 for a corporation (see *Legislation Act 2001*, s 133).

1 Name of regulation

This regulation is the *Mutual Recognition (Australian Capital Territory) Regulation 2017*.

3 Notes

4 Temporary exemption—Act, s 7

The following are laws to which the Commonwealth Act, section 15 applies:

- (a) the *Waste Management and Resource Recovery Act 2016*, part 10A (Container deposit scheme);
- (b) all other provisions of that Act, to the extent they relate to the container deposit scheme established by that part;
- (c) a regulation made under that Act, to the extent the regulation relates to the container deposit scheme.

Note Commonwealth Act—see the Act, s 4.

5 Expiry—regulation

This regulation expires 12 months after the day it commences.
