1 Name of regulation

This regulation is the *Crimes (Controlled Operations) Regulation 2017*.

2 Commencement

This regulation commences on the day after its notification day.

Note The naming and commencement provisions automatically commence on the notification day (see [Legislation Act](#), s 75 (1)).

- (h) the *Police (Special Investigative and Other Powers) Act 2015* (NT), part 2.
