**1 Name of regulation**

This regulation is the *Crimes (Assumed Identities) Regulation 2017*.

**2 Commencement**

This regulation commences on the day after its notification day.

*Note* The naming and commencement provisions automatically commence on the notification day (see [Legislation Act](#), s 75 (1)).

**3 Corresponding law—Act, dict, def *corresponding law***

The following laws are declared to correspond to the Act:

- (a) the *Crimes Act 1914* (Cwlth), part 1AC;
- (b) the *Law Enforcement and National Security (Assumed Identities) Act 2010* (NSW);

- (d) the *Police Powers and Responsibilities Act 2000* (Qld), chapter 12;
- (e) the *Criminal Investigation (Covert Powers) Act 2012* (WA), part 3;
- (f) the *Criminal Investigation (Covert Operations) Act 2009* (SA), part 3;
- (g) the *Police Powers (Assumed Identities) Act 2006* (Tas);
- (h) the *Police (Special Investigative and Other Powers) Act 2015* (NT), part 3.
