1 Name of regulation

This regulation is the Crimes (Assumed Identities) Regulation 2017.

2 Commencement

This regulation commences on the day after its notification day.

Note The naming and commencement provisions automatically commence on the notification day (see Legislation Act, s 75 (1)).

3 Corresponding law—Act, dict, def corresponding law

- (g) the Police Powers (Assumed Identities) Act 2006 (Tas);
- (h) the *Police (Special Investigative and Other Powers) Act 2015* (NT), part 3.
