## 1 Name of regulation

This regulation is the Crimes (Protection of Witness Identity) Regulation 2017.

#### 2 Commencement

This regulation commences on the day after its notification day.

*Note* The naming and commencement provisions automatically commence on the notification day (see Legislation Act, s 75 (1)).

## 3 Corresponding law—Act, dict, def corresponding law

- (g) the *Police (Special Investigative and Other Powers) Act 2015* (NT), part 4.
