1 Name of regulation

This regulation is the *Crimes (Protection of Witness Identity) Regulation 2017*.

2 Commencement

This regulation commences on the day after its notification day.

Note The naming and commencement provisions automatically commence on the notification day (see [Legislation Act](#), s 75 (1)).
