## **2 Commencement**

This regulation commences on the day after its notification day.

*Note* The naming and commencement provisions automatically commence on the notification day (see [Legislation Act](#), s 75 (1)).

## **3 Legislation amended**

This regulation amends the [Magistrates Court \(Lakes Infringement Notices\) Regulation 2004](#).

## **4 Section 5**

## **5 Administering authority**

The following entities are administering authorities for an infringement notice offence against the lakes legislation:

- (a) the delegate for lakes;
- (b) the chief police officer.

## **5 Section 9 (a) and (b)**

*substitute*

- (a) for an authorised person who is a police officer—the police officer’s service number; or
- (b) for an authorised person who is not a police officer—
  - (i) the authorised person’s full name, or surname and initials; or
  - (ii) any unique number given to the authorised person by the administering authority for this regulation.

## **6 Section 10 (a) and (b)**

*substitute*

- (a) for an authorised person who is a police officer—the police officer’s service number; or
- (b) for an authorised person who is not a police officer—
  - (i) the authorised person’s full name, or surname and initials; or
  - (ii) any unique number given to the authorised person by the administering authority for this regulation.

## **7 Section 11, new note**
