1 Name of rules

These rules are the *Court Procedures Amendment Rules 2020 (No 2)*.

2 Commencement

These rules commence on the day after their notification day.

Note The naming and commencement provisions automatically commence on the notification day (see [Legislation Act](#), s 75 (1)).

3 Legislation amended

These rules amend the *Court Procedures Rules 2006*.

4 Rule 6300

substitute

6300 Office hours

- (1) The registry must be open between 9.15 am and 1 pm, and between 2 pm and 4.15 pm, each day other than—
 - (a) a Saturday, Sunday or public holiday; or
 - (b) a day that falls between 26 December in a year and 1 January the following year; or
 - (c) a day, or part of a day, when a registrar directs that the registry is to be closed.
- (2) Before making a direction under subrule (1) (c), the registrar must if practicable consult the Chief Justice, the Chief Magistrate and the registrar of the other court.
- (3) A registrar may open the registry at other times.
- (4) In this rule:
registrar does not include a deputy registrar.
