## About this republication

### The republished law

This is a republication of the *Personal Violence (Transitional Provisions) Regulation 2025*, made under the *Personal Violence Act 2016* (including any amendment made under the *Legislation Act 2001*, part 11.3 (Editorial changes)) as in force on 8 July 2025. It also includes any commencement, repeal or expiry affecting this republished law to 22 November 2023.

The legislation history and amendment history of the republished law are set out in endnotes 3 and 4.

### Kinds of republications

The Parliamentary Counsel's Office prepares 2 kinds of republications of ACT laws (see the ACT legislation register at www.legislation.act.gov.au):

- authorised republications to which the *Legislation Act 2001* applies
- unauthorised republications.

The status of this republication appears on the bottom of each page.

### **Editorial changes**

The *Legislation Act 2001*, part 11.3 authorises the Parliamentary Counsel to make editorial amendments and other changes of a formal nature when preparing a law for republication. Editorial changes do not change the effect of the law, but have effect as if they had been made by an Act commencing on the republication date (see *Legislation Act 2001*, s 115 and s 117). The changes are made if the Parliamentary Counsel considers they are desirable to bring the law into line, or more closely into line, with current legislative drafting practice.

This republication does not include amendments made under part 11.3 (see endnote 1).

## **Uncommenced provisions and amendments**

If a provision of the republished law has not commenced, the symbol  $\bigcup$  appears immediately before the provision heading. Any uncommenced amendments that affect this republished law are accessible on the ACT legislation register (www.legislation.act.gov.au). ## **Modifications**

## **Penalties**

At the republication date, the value of a penalty unit for an offence against this law is \$160 for an individual and \$810 for a corporation (see *Legislation Act 2001*, s 133).

#### 1 Name of regulation

This regulation is the *Personal Violence (Transitional Provisions)* Regulation 2025.

#### 2 Commencement

- (1) Section 3 and schedule 1 are taken to have commenced on the commencement of the Justice (Age of Criminal Responsibility) Legislation Amendment Act 2023, section 120.
- (2) Section 4 and schedule 2 are taken to have commenced on the commencement of the Justice (Age of Criminal Responsibility) Legislation Amendment Act 2023, section 121.

Note The naming and commencement provisions are taken to have commenced on 22 November 2023 (see Legislation Act, s 75 (2)).

#### 3 Modification of Act, pt 23—Act, s 211 (2)

The Act, part 23 is modified by schedule 1.

#### 4 Modification of Act, pt 24—Act, s 221 (2)

The Act, part 24 is modified by schedule 2.

#### U 5 **Expiry**
