1 Name of regulation

This regulation is the *Motor Accident Injuries (Premiums and Administration) Amendment Regulation 2025 (No 1)*.

2 Commencement

This regulation commences on the day after its notification day.

Note The naming and commencement provisions automatically commence on the notification day (see [Legislation Act](#), s 75 (1)).

3 Legislation amended

This regulation amends the [Motor Accident Injuries \(Premiums and Administration\) Regulation 2019](#).

Note This regulation also amends the [Road Transport \(Offences\) Regulation 2005](#) (see sch 1).

4 New part 3D

Part 3D MAI insurance**13D Offence—registered operator use, or permit or allow use of, uninsured motor vehicle on road or road related area**

- (1) A person commits an offence if—
 - (a) the person—
 - (i) is the registered operator of a motor vehicle; and
 - (ii) uses, or permits or allows another person to use, the vehicle on a road or road related area; and

(b) the vehicle is not an insured motor vehicle.

Maximum penalty: 20 penalty units.

(2) This section does not apply to a registered operator of a motor vehicle if—

(a) there is an unregistered vehicle permit in force for the vehicle;
or

(b) the registration provisions do not apply to the vehicle because of the *Road Transport (Vehicle Registration) Regulation 2000*, part 2.2 (Vehicles not subject to registration provisions); or

(c) the motor vehicle is owned by—

(i) the Territory or a territory authority; or

(ii) the Commonwealth or a Commonwealth authority.

(3) An offence against this section is a strict liability offence.
