1 Name of regulation

This regulation is the *Motor Accident Injuries (Premiums and Administration) Amendment Regulation 2025 (No 1).*

2 Commencement

This regulation commences on the day after its notification day.

Note The naming and commencement provisions automatically commence on the notification day (see Legislation Act, s 75 (1)).

3 Legislation amended

This regulation amends the *Motor Accident Injuries (Premiums and Administration) Regulation 2019.*

Note This regulation also amends the *Road Transport (Offences)*Regulation 2005 (see sch 1).

Part 3D MAI insurance

- 13D Offence—registered operator use, or permit or allow use of, uninsured motor vehicle on road or road related area
 - (1) A person commits an offence if—
 - (a) the person—
 - (i) is the registered operator of a motor vehicle; and
 - (ii) uses, or permits or allows another person to use, the vehicle on a road or road related area; and

(b) the vehicle is not an insured motor vehicle.

Maximum penalty: 20 penalty units.

- (2) This section does not apply to a registered operator of a motor vehicle if—
 - (a) there is an unregistered vehicle permit in force for the vehicle; or
 - (b) the registration provisions do not apply to the vehicle because of the *Road Transport (Vehicle Registration) Regulation 2000*, part 2.2 (Vehicles not subject to registration provisions); or
 - (c) the motor vehicle is owned by—
 - (i) the Territory or a territory authority; or
 - (ii) the Commonwealth or a Commonwealth authority.
- (3) An offence against this section is a strict liability offence.
